Santiniketan, founded by Rabindranath Tagore, holds immense cultural significance as a center for art, education and a unique blend of Eastern and Western philosophies. Tagore's legacy is enduring with his contributions shaping India's cultural, educational and intellectual landscape. His influence on literature and music in Bengal is unparalleled and his compositions continue to inspire many generations.

Santiniketan exhibits the crystallisation of the ideas of Rabindranath Tagore and the pioneers of the Bengal School of Art. Set within the historical and geocultural context of early 20th-century colonial India, the ideas embodied in Santiniketan influenced educational and cultural institutions in south Asia.

It's a vibrant center for various art forms, including painting, sculpture, music, dance and drama nurturing a unique blend of Indian and international artistic influences. The town is deeply intertwined with Tagore's life, works and vision with his former residence, [Uttarayan](#) now serving as a museum.

It actively preserves and promotes Indian art and culture with alumni like Nandalal Bose and Ram Kinker Baij making significant contributions to modern Indian art.
