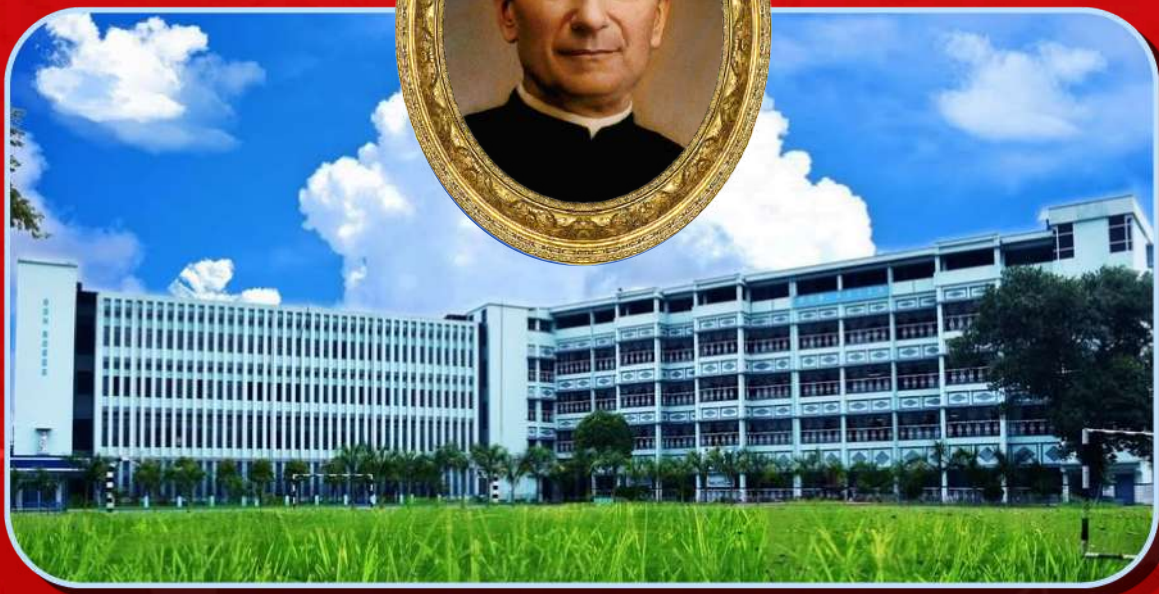
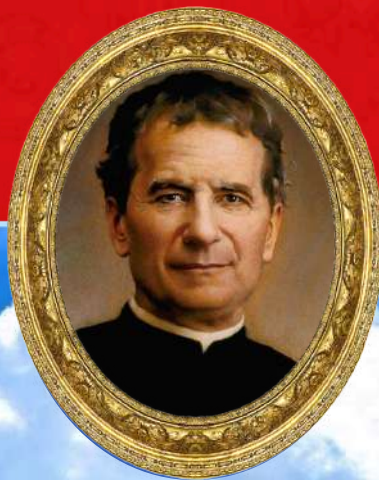

May Day 2026

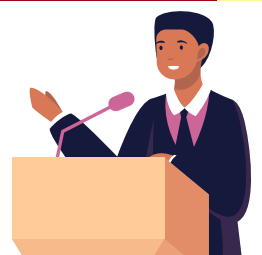
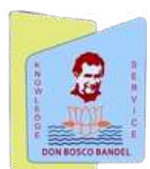
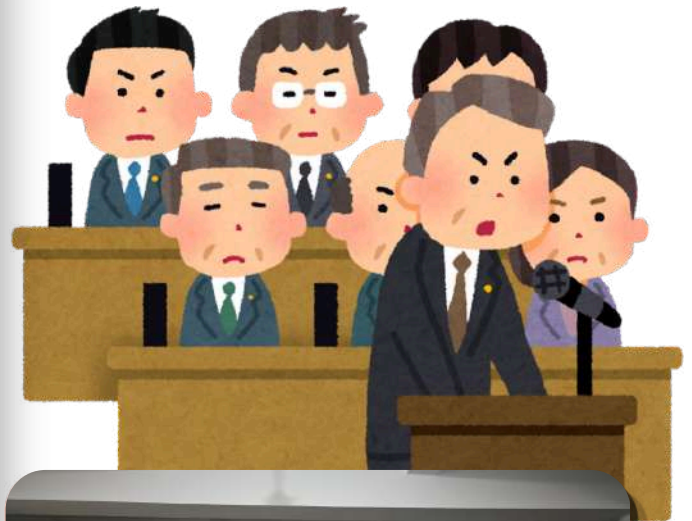

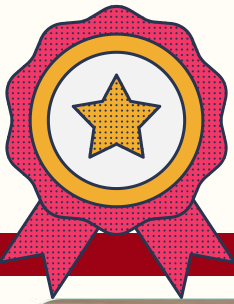




Jadavpur University MUN

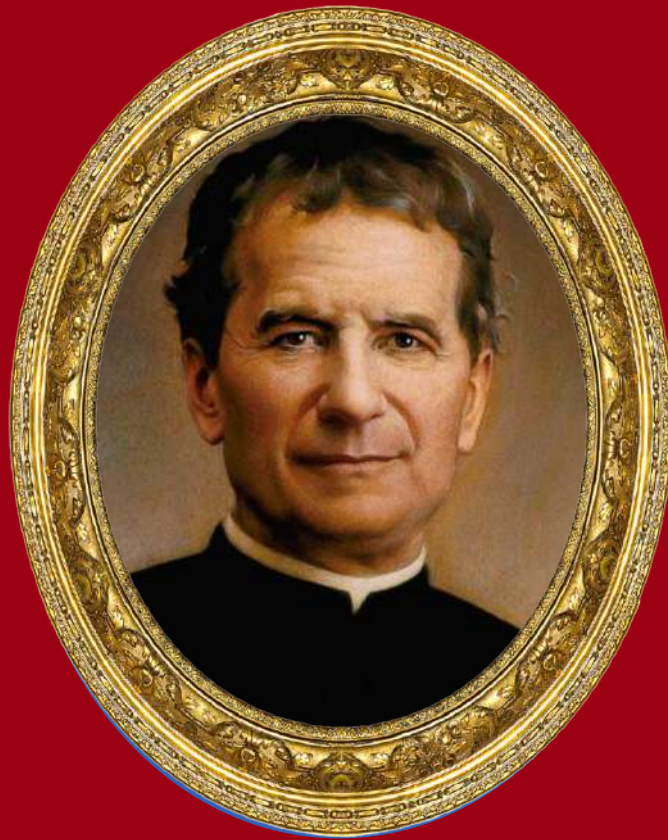
RABINDRA JAYANTI 2026
