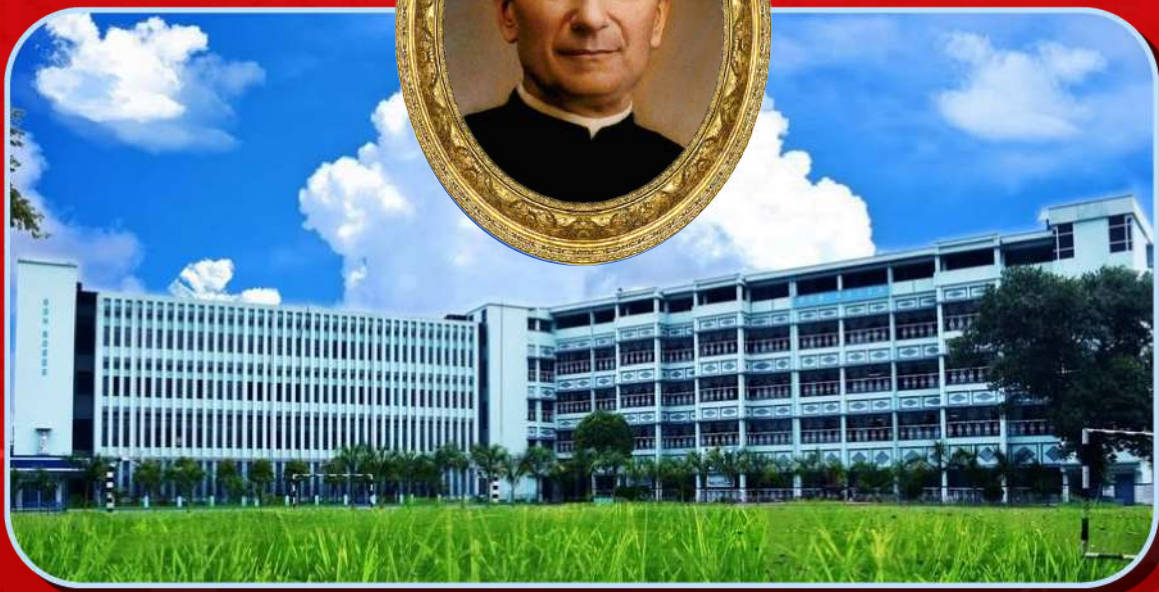
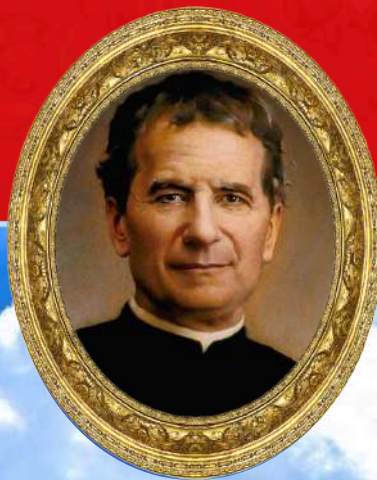

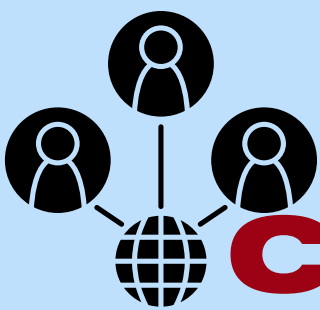
DBB EXCURSION

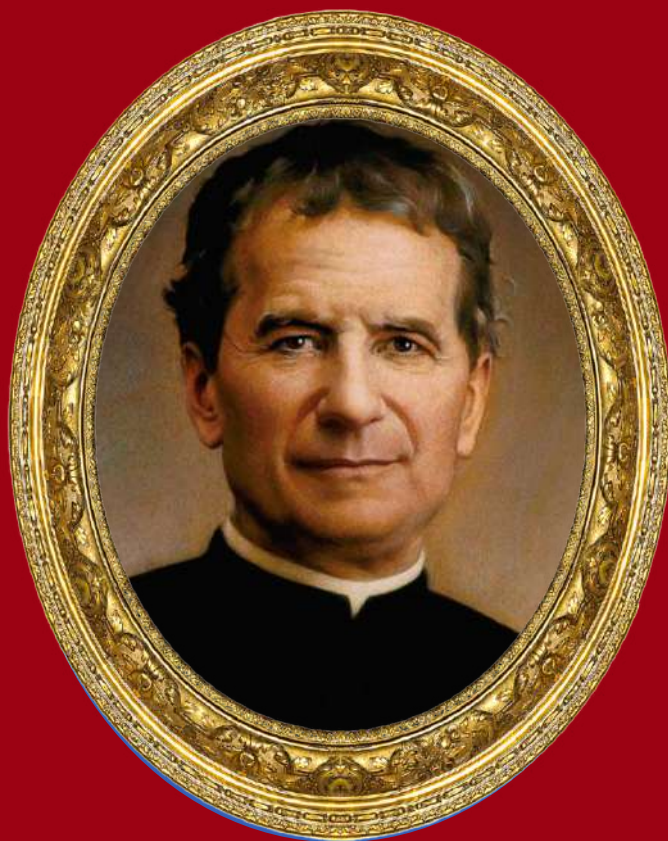
All India Open Speed Skating Championship
